Objectives:

- Students will be able to Identify an Ostinato
- Students will be able to create a two to four measure rhythmic ostinato as an alternate accompaniment

Procedures:

- 1. Students will enter room to "We Will Rock You" playing
- 2. Students will participate in collaborative board activity to assess their prior knowledge
- 3. Students will be introduced to the day's goals
- 4. Students will watch short video on Mr. Gossard's Classroom
- 5. Students will define an ostinato
- 6. Students will learn chrome music lab instructions
- 7. Class will recreate the ostinato from "We Will Rock You" on Chrome Music Lab
- 8. Students will be given time to experiment and create rhythms/ostinatos in chrome music lab
- 9. Students will share their compositions
- 10. Students will be formally assessed on ostinatos, rhythms, and musical examples heard in class.
- 11. Students will participate in "Time to Climb" activity

Assessment:

Formal and informal Assessments will be given using nearpod and in class collaboration throughout lesson.

Assessments will be nearpod polls, nearpod draw activities, compositions created by students, and nearpod time to climb activity.
